We ask that you support the fight against discrimination and violation of Civil rights of the Descendants of Freedmen of the Five Civilized Tribes. (Cherokee, Creek, Choctaw, Seminole, and Creek).

In order to fight discrimination, the Descendants of Freedmen—persons whose ancestors were enslaved by Indian tribes prior to the signing of 1866 treaty agreements between the tribes and the US government - must continue to have legal support to continue federal lawsuits such as *Vann et al versus Salazar* and *Cherokee Nation Vs Nash et al* . At stake are political rights (voting) and economic rights such as health care, housing, and educational benefits which are legally available to members of federally recognized Indian tribes. In opposition to the freedmen rights are tribal governments, formerly wealthy due to slavery. They now channel their casino wealth to lawyers, lobbyists, and Washington elected politicians to deny the freedmen enforcement of their legal 1866 treaty rights.

Education of the public by the freedmen costs money. Fundraisers such as banquets, etc. also cost money.
